Community Art Projects

CCAL has partnered with the Town of Chapin to provide art for the community. CCAL artists created large metal sailboats for its inaugural community art project in 2018. A large mural was painted at their home base, Crooked Creek Park in 2019. In 2021, square metal trail markers were painted. In 2023 a seven-foot tall, three-sided mosaic obelisk sculpture and a large-scale mural downtown were unveiled. In 2024 turtle art rocked the town. Most projects end with an auction of the artwork to raise funds for future projects. Most of the artwork remains in public spaces. Collectively, these pieces comprise the Chapin Art Trail, a selfguided tour of over 30 pieces of art displayed throughout the town. CCAL hopes these artworks serve to inspire and remind residents and visitors of Chapin's unique beauty.
